## **Terms of Reference**

## **Consultant – Evidence Syntheses**

National Health Systems Resource Centre (NHSRC) has been set up under the National Health Mission (NHM) as an autonomous registered society, to channelize technical assistance and capacity building support to the states for strengthening the public health system. The NHSRC is also mandated to contribute towards National strategic health planning and programme design.

The NHSRC together with its technical partner The George Institute for Global Health, India and with support from the Alliance for Health Policy and Systems Research, World Health Organisation (WHO-AHPSR) will set up an Embedded Rapid Evidence Syntheses Unit (ERESU) and seeks to employ consultants for this purpose, purely on a contractual basis.

- Conduct rapid evidence syntheses of appropriate quality to deliver rapid review products as per timelines
- Present products in different formats to different stakeholders
- Disseminate ERESU products in various formats
- Conduct training activities on rapid evidence syntheses
- Organise and conduct dissemination events, including liaising with various stakeholders for the purpose
- Advocacy of ERESU and its products in different fora and with various stakeholders
- Contribute to peer-reviewed publications
- Contribute to and implement strategic document on sustainability of ERESU
- Contribute to and implement process evaluation of the ERESU
- Conduct methodological research on the domain of rapid evidence syntheses and knowledge translation
- Identify and document best practices and innovations within ERESU
- Undertake such other assignments, which may be assigned by from time to time by the ERESU leads ,or the Executive Director NHSRC
