1. Background

5. Qualifications and experience

- A Medical graduate (MBBS) with Post graduate degree/diploma in Public Health Management / Preventive & Social Medicine/Hospital Health Care Management or any postgraduate medical qualification with minimum of 7 (Seven) years of post qualification work experience in the field of public health.
- Experience in working for reform health systems and management of change in health sector.
